4 x	Adrenaline <b>1:1000/1ml</b> ampoules
1 x	Adrenaline <b>1:10,000</b> 10ml minijet (or ampoule)
2 x	Amiodarone <b>150mg/3ml</b> ampoules
4 x	Aspirin <b>300mg</b> Dispersible Tablets
2 x	Atropine Sulphate <b>600mcg/1ml</b> ampoules
2 x	Benztropine <b>2mg/2ml</b> ampoules
4 x	Frusemide <b>20mg/2ml</b> ampoules
1 x	Glucagon <b>1ml</b> Injection (HypoKit)
1 x	Glucose 50% <b>25mg/50ml</b> vial
2 x	Haloperidol <b>5mg/1ml</b> ampoules
2 x	Hydralazine <b>20mg/2ml</b> ampoules
2 x	Hydrocortisone <b>100mg</b> vials
1 x	Hyoscine Butylbromide <b>20mg/1ml</b> ampoule
2 x	Ipratropium <b>500mcg/1ml</b> nebulas
1 x	Ipratropium <b>21mcg/dose</b> inhaler
1 x Bottle	Isosorbide Dinitrate <b>5mg</b> tablets
2 x	Lignocaine <b>1% 5ml</b> ampoules (for local anaesthetic)
2 x	Metoclopramide <b>10mg/2ml</b> ampoules
4 x	Midazolam <b>5mg/1ml</b> ampoules
2 x	<b>Morphine 10mg/1ml</b> ampoules (collect from DD Safe)
1 x	Naloxone <b>400mcg/1ml</b> Minijet
2 x	Naloxone <b>400mcg/1ml</b> ampoules
10 x	Paracetamol <b>500mg</b> tablets
2 x	Promethazine <b>50mg/2ml</b> ampoules
5 x	Salbutamol <b>5mg/2.5ml</b> nebulas
1 x	Salbutamol <b>100mcg/dose</b> inhaler
5 x	Sodium Chloride 0.9% <b>10ml</b> ampoules
3 x	Thiamine 100mg ampoules injection – listed in Low BGL protocol...MUST be given before Glucose if patient is a known drinker
5 x	Water for Injection <b>10ml</b> ampoules
2 x	Spacers for Bronchodilator Inhalers – disposable (place in container on top of drugs)
	Labels for Emergency Drug Syringes: 5 x Adrenaline, 2 x Metoclopramide, 4 x Midazolam, 2 x Morphine, 5 x Normal Saline, 5 x blank labels
