






Medicare Items Provided by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Practitioners and Remote Area Nurses Medicare Revenue PHC Remote Cheat Sheet

ATSIHP = Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Health Practitioner RAN = Remote Area Nurse
RMP = Remote Medical Practitioner

<p>ATSIHP, RAN or RMP</p>	<p><i>To be eligible to claim the items below, the test must be conducted as per CARPA or standard practice, or as directed by the RMP. Examples: Hb for HSAK or antenatal; pregnancy test before Depo; ECG as per CDMP.</i></p>

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ATSIHP	10988 Immunisation Per presentation, not per immunisation \$ 12.00	10989 Wound Care The RMP must conduct an initial assessment of the wound. This can be by phone, but needs to be noted in the client's medical record. \$ 12.00					
ATSIHP or RAN	10987 Health Check Follow-up <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Only ATSI clients eligible Service consistent with the needs identified through the health check Can only be claimed after a doctor has claimed a health check (item 715) Maximum of 10 claims per client per calendar year \$ 24.00	10997 Chronic Disease Review <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Review as written in the client's chronic disease management plan Can only be claimed after a doctor has claimed a chronic disease management plan (items 721, 723, 732 etc) Maximum of 5 claims per client per calendar year \$ 12.00	10983 Telehealth Support Service by a RAN or ATSIHP that requires the provision of clinical support of a client who is at an Aboriginal Medical Service, and who is participating in a video consultation with a specialist or consultant physician. This item cannot be claimed at the same time as an RMP's Telehealth item for the one client. \$ 32.40				
MIDWIVES only	16400 Antenatal Check <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Can only be claimed 10 times per pregnancy A bulk billing incentive item (10991) cannot be claimed in conjunction with item 16400 Cannot be claimed in conjunction with another antenatal attendance item eg, 16500, on the same day \$ 23.20 <p style="text-align: right;"><i>Note: For DoH, only midwives can claim this item.</i></p>						
ALL	Medicare Incentive for Bulk Billing <table style="width: 100%; border: none;"> <tr> <td style="text-align: right;">10991 for General Services</td> <td style="text-align: right;">\$ 9.25</td> </tr> <tr> <td style="text-align: right;">74991 for Pathology</td> <td style="text-align: right;">\$ 9.10</td> </tr> </table> Can be added to every Medicare item (except item 16400) if the client is under 16 years of age, or holds a Commonwealth Concession Card (most clients who don't work hold concession cards and so are eligible for this item with every other item claimed). Example: if 10997 & 11700 & 73802 are claimed and the client has a concession card or is under 16 years of age, then this client is also eligible to claim item 10991 with 10997 <u>and</u> 10991 with item 11700 <u>and</u> 74991 with item 73802			10991 for General Services	\$ 9.25	74991 for Pathology	\$ 9.10

ATSIHP, RAN or RMP	To be eligible to claim the items below, the test must be conducted as per CARPA or standard practice, or as directed by the RMP. Examples: Hb for HSAK or antenate; pregnancy test before Depo; ECG as per CDMP. The items below can only be claimed by RAN, ATSIHP <u>or</u> RMP on the same day eg, RAN & RMP cannot both claim 11700 on the same day.						
73802 Hb Can claim using either the I-stat or hemocue \$ 3.95 Medicare Incentive 74991		73806 Pregnancy test \$ 8.70 Medicare Incentive 74991	11700 ECG Can claim a maximum of three (3) ECGs on the one day per client. If more than one ECG is claimed, it must be noted on the claim "1 st ECG", "2 nd ECG" etc. \$ 26.60 Medicare Incentive 10991
